(2) Understand the causes of untapped production potentials

(a) Yield gaps, yield and land use limiting factors(b) Reduce the yield gap and increase resource efficiency





Research objectives (3/4)

(3) Explore developments in agricultural supply chains

(a) Factors influencing efficiency
(b) Implications of policy interventions
(c) Provide estimates of food, feed and biomass potentials by 2025/2030

(4) Enhance the analytical framework for future scenario assessments

(a) AGMEMOD

WP1 Statistical database and inventory of policies



 Objective: to collect and process data of key economic indicators of the agri-food sector, of budgetary support and other specific data needed for country reviews (WP2)

• Output: a consolidated database

• Status: completed (to be updated in 2016)





WP2 Country reviews

 Objective: to describe structures and developments of the agri-food sector, in its general economic context

Output: Country reports, Market Synthesis report, Policy synthesis report

• Status: completed



WP3 Untapped potentials of agricultural production



 Objective: to assess current and potential land use, yield gaps and production potential

 Output: land use map; report on yield gaps; report on biomass production potential

Status: completed



WP4 Explore competitive chain

- Objective: to assess performance, market competition and market power, and evaluate role of institutions and policies on supply chain performance
- Output: report on agri-food supply chains' performance; on market structure and price formation in selected chains, and on institution and supply chain performance
- Status: in progress



WP5 Toolbox development



- Objective: to improve, extend and link models that will be used to project agricultural markets in the 8countries, the EU and rest of World
- Output: conceptual framework report; model revision and extension reports; report on linking and operating system of combined models
- Status: in progress







- Objective: to analyse impacts of market, technology and policy scenarios on production, use and trade of CIS and consequences for future trade relations EU-CIS
- Output: reports on scenario outcomes (including country notes summarising the set of scenario outcomes for each country)
- Status: in progress
