Excursion to the wetlands in Southern Finland

On 6 September 2012 the researchers of the Division of Farm and Enterprises Economics of Lithuanian Institute of Agrarian Economics (LIAE) – Dr Irena Kriščiukaitienė and Virginia Namiotko – visited two constructed wetlands in Southern Finland. The purpose of the excursion was to understand how the constructed wetlands function in nature and how they could contribute to reduce pollution.

Experts from Finnish Environment Institute (SYKE) and Agrifood Research Finland (MTT) demonstrated the multifunctionality of the constructed wetlands and automatic continuous monitoring of nitrate and turbidity. They also presented the instruments and data that show accurately the efficiency of the wetland to retain nutrients and the way how to improve this efficiency with added chemicals.
